What's New:

- Reminders about Northeast Arrival Procedures:
 - There is NO parking on Grove Street in front of the school on either side of the street. The MPD will ticket cars that are parked on Grove St.
 - Car Line: If you use the car line then you should NOT get out of your car. If you do not wish to leave your child until they have entered the building, you may either park your car on a side street and walk your child to school or plan to arrive at the car line after 8:10. Cars without children in them may not remain in the car line after children have exited the vehicle.
- Electronic Devices: Please remind your children not to bring any electronic devices, including smartphones, smart watches, apple watches, and gizmo watches to school with them. These are not educational tools and should be kept at home. If a child requires a device for after-school use, it must remain in the student's backpack and out of sight during the school day. Please also note that the school will not be responsible for any damaged, lost, or stolen items brought from home. Thank you.
